Registration: All archers are asked to register upon arrival, to confirm their target allocation in case of any late alterations. Proof of membership will be required for registration.

Equipment inspection: Before/during practice on both days.

Dress: AGB dress regulation 307 rule will apply.

Shooting: 70M or 60M for all Recurve/Longbow archers with four archers per boss; 50M for Barebow archers with four archers per boss; 50M for Compound archers with four archers per boss. Two details. The tournament will be shot to World Archery rules in force at the time of the event.

Refreshments/Food: Details will be provided on the target list.

Arrows: This is a multi-use sports field and all arrows must be found. Therefore lost arrows must be reported to a judge or a member of the field party.

Drug Testing: Record status shoots are liable for Drug Testing. Any competitor approached to give samples for testing MUST comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry form giving consent for junior archers to be tested if approached. Failure to countersign the form in this way will make the entry unacceptable in respect of that junior unless a parent or LEGAL guardian is attending the shoot.

Awards: Medals will be awarded each day based on the numbers of entries in each category. WA Target awards will be available on Saturday and Sunday.

Covid-19: The tournament will be subject to government rules at the time of the event. If you feel unwell, or have symptoms of flu or COVID-19, please do not attend the event.

Payments: Entry fee is £20 per day. Please email entry forms accompanied by BACS payment (Reference: Surname or AGB number; Sort code: **309149**; Account number **00090110**). Booking via Eventbrite is also available. For postal entries payment must be by BACS. If you wish confirmation of entry please provide an e-mail address.
